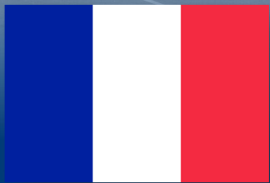

Darwen Academy MFL 2011-2012

- 2011-2012 has seen the popularity of language study increase again at DACA. Numbers of pupils choosing to study a GCSE language has increased four- fold .
- Pupils will continue to be involved with exchanges involving our partner schools in France, Spain and Finland.
- 2011-2012 saw DACA's first ever Dual Linguists attaining GCSE's in both French and Spanish.
- Successful grades at AS level French have been achieved this year.
- French and Spanish are now offered to Year 7 pupils.

MFL Courses offered at DACA

KS3

Year 7 and 8 pupils study either French or Spanish. Collaborative learning methods ensure pupils are actively engaged in their own language acquisition.

KS4

At KS4 we offer French/Spanish GCSE. These are flexible 1 year courses which allow pupils the option of choosing a 2nd language in later years. Alternatively pupils may choose to opt for enrichment language lessons in future years as preparation for A level.
