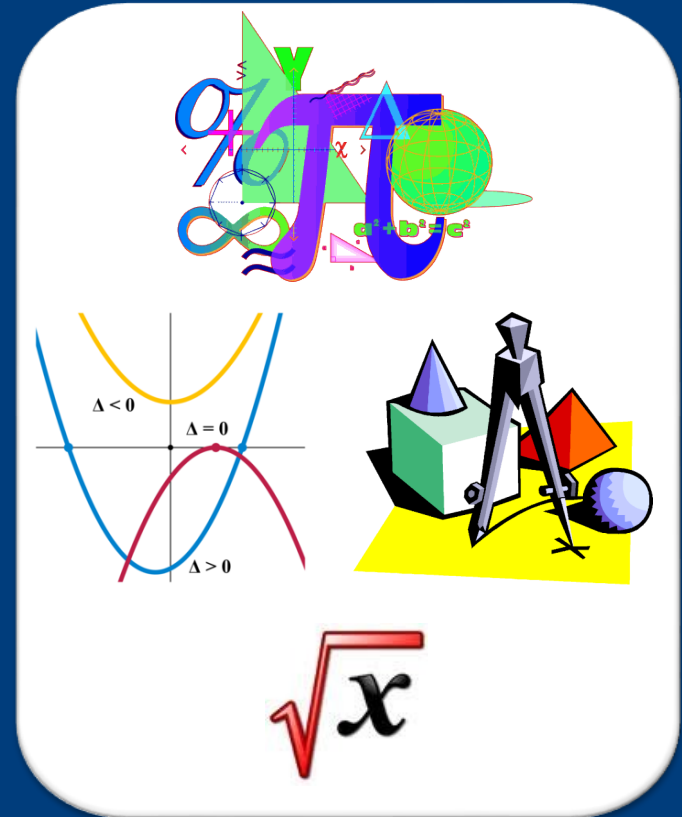

## How we monitor student progress and keep you informed

Throughout each Term all teachers will constantly monitor the progress of every student, particularly looking for anyone falling behind and taking swift and effective action as needed. You will be informed if any special action is required.

At the end of each Term, (six weeks), all students will be assessed on those parts of the Mathematics Curriculum taught in that Term.

You will be informed of the outcome of that assessment and of any special action that may be required if your child has underperformed.

# Numeracy

The Mathematics Faculty leads the Academy determination to ensure that all students are sufficiently numerate that there will be no numeracy barrier to their learning, both during their life in education and work.

All students will have their Numeracy Level assessed in September and if they are found to have insufficient skills they will receive additional teaching to rectify that shortfall.
